## The fatwa of the Muslim League regarding the Corona virus

Praise be to God, Lord of the worlds, and prayers and peace be upon the Messenger of God, may God bless him and grant him peace

What is not hidden from anyone, we are all aware of the seriousness of the spread of the Corona virus epidemic. Taking it into consideration in regards to questions about Friday prayers and congregational prayers in the country in which this virus has appeared, we respond with God's help as follows:

Friday prayers and congregational prayers are cancelled due to several reasons, including fear. So whoever fears that he or she might get infected with this deadly disease, attending congregational prayers is not an obligation for him or her and should not attend them, and whoever suspects himself of having a disease, he must not attend the congregation prayers and events.

Likewise, leaving Friday prayer and congregation prayers becomes a duty, because in our case, the duty to preserve ones life is only accomplished by means such as not gathering in places of assembly and mosques.

For this, the Council of Imams and the Council of Fatwa in the Islamic League in the Republic of Poland has agreed upon the closure of Islamic centers for a period of not less than two weeks and taking all necessary measures to avoid this deadly epidemic.
